- These are monthly packages lessons do not float month to month.

****We are strongly encouraging everyone to take 2x per week if possible. Just like with any other sport (soccer, football, gymnastics ect) you need to be in the saddle to improve your riding. ****

You will need to ride a minimum of 2X per week if you want to ride in over the 2'-2'3 classes and you must own or lease for classes above 2'3-2'6"

There is a \$35 registration fee due at your first lesson or paid via paypal. Each student must also purchase (or have) a grooming kit. They may be purchased for \$12 from Stony Glen.

LESSON PAYMENT IS DUE AT YOUR FIRST LESSON OF THE MONTH TO GET THE PACKAGE DISCOUNT. IF PAYMENT IS NOT MADE AT THE FIRST LESSON YOU WILL BE THE CHARGED INDIVIDUAL LESSON FEE FOR EACH LESSON THAT MONTH.

YOU MAYNOT PRORATE LESSON PACKAGES

ALL CANCELATIONS MUST BE MADE 24 HOURS IN ADVANCE ON THE ONLINE SYSTEM IN ORDER NOT BE CHARGED FOR LESSON. We are sorry but there are NO exceptions on this policy

Weather Cancellations:

- .If a lesson is canceled due to bad weather an email will go out as soon as a decision is made. It will be emailed or texted to you
- .If you are not sure about your lesson PLEASE CALL! (214) 724-6017. Please call about your lesson if:
 1. the temperature is under 35 degrees
 2. the actual temperature is over 100 degrees
 3. Storms are eminent
 4. Sever high winds Please check email for weather notification prior to leaving for lessons.

*We will do our best to reschedule bad weather days but it is not guaranteed.

Rescheduling- we will do our best to reschedule your lesson if you cancel within the correct time frame but we cannot promise we will have spaces. Often times you will need to wait for someone else to cancel in get into a class. Missed lessons will not float from month to month.

Arrival time: Riders should arrive 15 minutes before their lesson begins (more

if it takes you longer to tack up).

Departure Time: When your lesson is over please make sure you have enough time to properly care for your horse. They will need to be cooled out and cleaned up and maybe even hosed and dried in warmer weather. If you do not have the time please let your instructor know so you may leave class early to take care of your horse or we will do it for \$25.

Late Arrivals: If you are running late but are coming CALL US!! If you are more than 15 minutes late, it will be considered a no show and YOU WILL be charged for the lesson. If you need someone to tack up for you we can arrange that for \$15 per tack up

Drop offs- please do not drop off riders under the age of 12 yrs at the barn for their lessons. If you do drop off make sure their ride is there at the end time of the lesson. This is especially true if you are the last lesson of the night as the trainers need to get home too. Unattended riders will be charged \$15/15 min starting 15 min after the conclusion of their lesson.

Attire and Equipment

Students should be in neat attire with your shirt tucked in and have all the

required items.

-Hair should be pulled back in a low ponytail/braid. --

-**Riding boots and Helmets** must be purchased for regular lessons.

Paddock boots or tall boots no Cowboy boots or fashion boots are allowed.

Riding helmets only colored helmets are fine for lessons but you must have black to show.

We have lots of used items as well if you are interested in these please email me.

****Gloves are required for all jumping lessons****

Students should ride in riding pants, stretch pants or tight fitting jeans. NO BELL BOTTOM JEANS or capris ALLOWED.

Half Chaps are highly encouraged to prevent pinching from the stirrup leathers.

No sweat pants or shorts. -Mid thigh length shorts must be worn under full chaps.

Minimal jewelry should be worn.

No gum or cell phones allowed on the horse.

Grooming Supplies:

STONY GLEN DOES NOT PROVIDE GROOMING SUPPLIES FOR STUDENTS. You may either purchase a grooming kit from us for \$12 or you can put one together for yourself.

Your grooming kit should include:

Hoof Pick *Hard Brush *Soft Brush *Curry comb
Sponge * Fly Spray * Extra Rags (are great to help them dry)

Other handy Items :

Crop Square saddle pad jumping
boots for horse

Hairnets

Tacking/Untacking: We will provide lessons once a month (\$50 for both parents and

riders) going over the care, grooming and tacking of the horse. If you are not comfortable with this Please sign up!!!!

If you will be needing assistance to tack and un-tack your horse or pony after that time frame please understand that is it "part" of your lesson time. Because tacking up takes an additional 15 minutes we cannot allow riders into high level lessons that cannot do the majority of tack and untacking independently.

*we can arrange for your horse to be tacked up or untacked and cooled out for you. There is a charge for both of these services

Holiday Schedules: During summer, Christmas break and other long holiday's lesson schedules will vary. It is your responsibility to let the trainer know (in writing) your plans for the holidays. Do not assume that your lesson is on without checking with the staff. The online system has made this much easier but please remember it is YOUR responsibility

Practice Rides: (\$30) Practice rides must be scheduled. Practice rides are only offered to students who are in group lessons that can tack and un-tack un-assisted. If you do practice rides or half lease a horse please remember **that you may NOT jump** unless you are in a lesson. No exceptions.

Leasing- This is a wonderful way to see if horse ownership is for you or to just get more rides in!
